**June 23 & July 21 During worship**

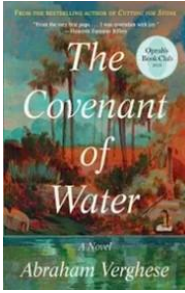

**MEAL A MONTH COLLECTION**

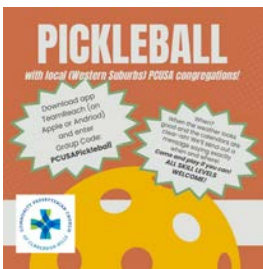

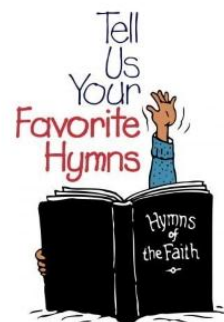
**FAVORITE HYMN SUNDAY**
